STORY

The grapes that give life to these wines come from the centenary estate of Mayor Drummond, in Luján de Cuyo, where the winery is located. There, they have always worked in a sustainable way, but it was in 2015 that the official process to certify organically the vineyards and their grapes, which were planted in 1906, began.

Ideal with grilled meats and cheese and cold meat boards. It also goes very well with poultry with cream sauce and white fish.
